What is PETS?

PETS is TPTCL's Online bid submission Portal. Doing away with the oldschool procedure of bid aggregation through mail, TPTCL moved on to the new state-of-the-art Bidding portal from 1st April 2014.

How to access PETS?

PETS is available to all our clients who are registered on IEX/PXIL.

What are the system requirements to use PETS?

- Internet Connectivity
- Browser: Google Chrome, Firefox, Opera and IE (version 8.0 and above)
- Basic Software such as Microsoft Office and PDF reader

What services are available for clients on PETS?

Following services are available:

- Bid Submission/Cancellation/Modification
- Obligation Details : Bid Quantum and Clear Quantum of last 5 days
- Clearance Price : Min., Max., Avg. of last 5 days
- NOC validity Period
- Exchange Registration Validity Period
- Account Summary like balance amount, last amount paid with date and mode of payment
- REC details
 - Operational Limits
 - Market Rates

What types of Bids can be placed on PETS?

Both single bids and block bids can be placed on PETS.

What is the cut-off time to place bids?

11:00 AM of the trading date is the cut-off to place bids. It is highly advisable to NOT to wait for the cutoff time and submit your bids well beforehand to ensure bid security.

What is the procedure to place bids?

Bids can be submitted in two ways:

1. Upload standard bid excel file

- a. Download the Sample Excel template file for bid placing.
- b. Fill that downloaded excel and upload filled file to PxS Portal
- c. After uploading excel file click on submit button

2. Place the Bid manually by filling data in PxS Software

- a. Select Power Exchange Tab (IEX or PXIL) and Click Place New Bid
- b. Select Exchange, Bidding type (Single or Block Bid) and Delivery date
- c. Select Time Slot (From – To), Price, Bid Quantum and save
- d. After filling all the slots click on submit button to place your bid.
- e. Cancel and Edit facility of bid for current and future date.
- f. Bid details of last 10 days are available as well as provision to place same bid as before.
- g. When Bid submit option is clicked, an email is sent to the email ID enrolled for checking Purpose

What reports can be accessed through PETS?

Following reports are accessible through PETS:

Total Clearance report:

It provides the Bid Report (Bid Quantum and Approved Quantum) with the option to select report between any two days with the feature of exporting it to excel

Avg Price Detail:

This report provides the average price per MWH for the power traded through Exchange.

Quantum Traded Detail:

This report gives the analyses of power traded in peak and off-peak hours.

Can bills/obligations/Injection sheets be downloaded from PETS?

Yes, the download facility is provided in the Download segment for such documents.

Can NOC be also sent through PETS?

Yes, NOC for Exchange transactions can also be submitted through PETS.
